

## **THE IMPACT OF PLACEMENTS ON EDUCATIONAL AND CAREER INTENTIONS**

### **Project Description**

Our study aims to characterise the impact clinical placements and other educational factors have on educational satisfaction and career intentions; to characterise what educational factors contribute to student satisfaction on rotations. With the vast increases in medical students' numbers, determining the factors that influence a student's educational satisfaction and overall satisfaction on a rotation is important from both a clinical placement capacity, funding and resource standpoint. It is expected that student satisfaction on rotations impact their choice of specialty and that staff/student ratio, patient load and dedicated teaching time influence student satisfaction.
